Americanism Essay Contest

- The Americanism Essay Contest was created to teach students the value of patriotism and what it means to be Americans. Thousands of students participate in the program each year and help promote a lifelong respect of our flag and country.
- Students (grades 3 to 12) explore the fundamental rights and freedoms we enjoy today. Each year's contest has a different theme; one student in each category per division is awarded a prize. There is a category for students with special needs.
- Current Essay Theme: "What does America the Beautiful mean to me (regarding veterans and our military)?"

Questions have been asked how to explain the Essay Topic to school age children. Here are some examples;

- America the Beautiful to me is our freedoms we exercise every day because of our Veterans and our Military.
 - Freedom of speech
 - Freedom of religion
 - The right to keep and bear arms
 - Freedom of assembly and the freedom to petition.
 - Freedom of expression.
 - Freedom of movement.
 - Right to vote.
- All above is because of our Veterans and Military.

Units

- Set deadline to receive essays
 - Provide information to schools (public, private, parochial, home schools) and other organizations (Boy & Girl Scouts, 4-H Clubs, Young Marines, etc.)
 - I suggest that you provide this information to the Schools this fall.
 - Include
 - Requested return date (deadline)
 - Cover Sheet
 - Other Unit specific instructions
